


# **Beginner Band Notes**

Beginner Band students and families are invited to attend the Sounds of the Stadium on Monday, October 2nd! It is a wonderful evening of band music. Tickets are free for students/children and Denton ISD employees, and \$4 for adults. See below for how to reserve your tickets. It's so awesome to see all of the bands in the district and to see the UNT Green Brigade Marching Band (which Mrs. Anderson is a proud alumni of). Students are moving along well in beginner band and should be practicing their instruments at home each day. All classes are playing on the small parts of their instruments and on the full instruments. Students are also working on rhythm pass-offs and alphabet pass-offs. Band shirts will be delivered at the end of the week. We will start distributing those to all students who have paid their band fee (or first payment of their band fee) already.

## **Advanced Band Notes**

We had a UIL Grade Check on Friday. Students who are not passing one or more classes on the report that I will receive on Monday will be notified by me or Mr. Hudson and will not be allowed to perform at extracurricular events (which for band this 3 weeks is Sounds of the Stadium). Students can gain eligibility back on their report card in 3 weeks. For all of those eligible students, see the info below on how to purchase/reserve your tickets. I will send an email tomorrow with all of the Sounds of the Stadium details - performance times, when to meet, where we will be sitting, etc. We will be receiving our band t-shirts from our shirt company on Thursday. We will be distributing those to students that have paid their band fee (or first payment of their band fee). We need these shirts for our performance.

Honors Band - dont't forget to be attending sectionals and that our scale pass-off will be a major grade. Each scale is worth 10 points (once all 9 are passed off a bonus 10 points will be given for their 100!). So if I enter a 30 for their grade in the grade-book, that means they have only completed 3 scales. None of these scales are new to them as they were taught all of these in beginner band. Please check in and ask your child how many they have passed off and encourage them to complete those scales.

Symphonic Band - students in this group are also working on scale pass-offs in class.

Students are working on these scales in class as well as the pep band tunes for Sounds of the Stadium. Symphonic Band does a scale pass-off each week in class on the assigned scale for that week and can also reassess ones from prior weeks. There is a chart in class for students to see what they've passed off and what they need to still work on.
