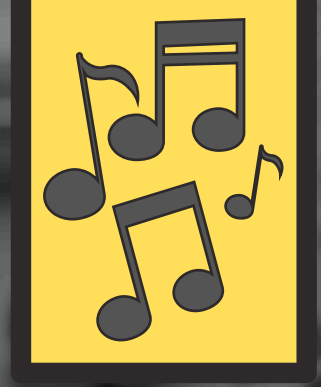

8TH GRADE NIGHT

8th Grade Students will get to participate with the High School Marching Band at their football game this Friday night, October 18th. Students will meet their band buddies, play alongside members of the band in the stands, and perform at half time with the Bwell Band! Here's the itinerary (a more detailed one will be sent home with students and emailed on Tuesday):

- 4:00pm - 6:00pm - We will bus over to Carrico Stadium to drop off school items and instruments in a secure location, walk into Braswell to meet band students, eat pizza, etc. (Dress - wear jeans and we will provide you a Braswell Shirt - check the weather as you may need to layer)
- 6:00pm - March over to stadium with Braswell Band and take a seat in the band section to watch their pre-game performance of their competitive marching show.
- 6:45pm - Get instruments from secure location and go back to stands with band students
- 7:00pm - Game begins against Flower Mound HS
- Halftime - Perform on the field our pep tunes with Braswell Band
- 9:15-9:30pm - End of Game. Parents need to pick up students at Carrico Stadium at the end of the game. Students will remain with the band until the game is over.
