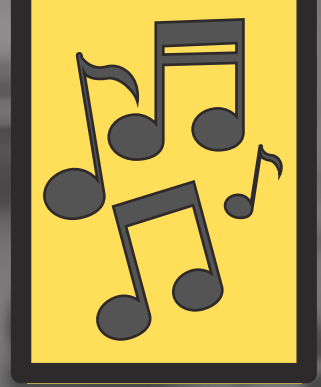

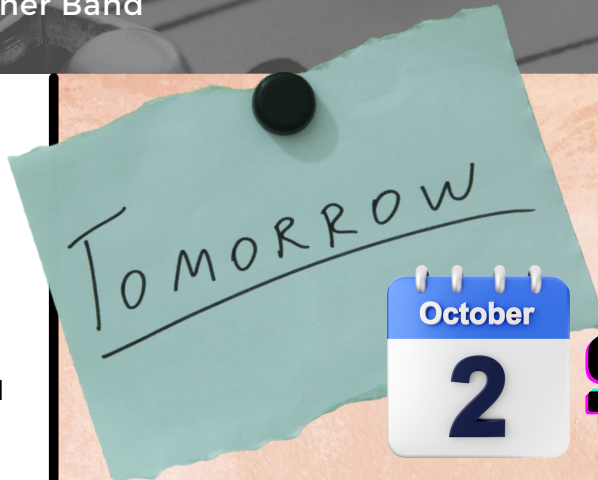

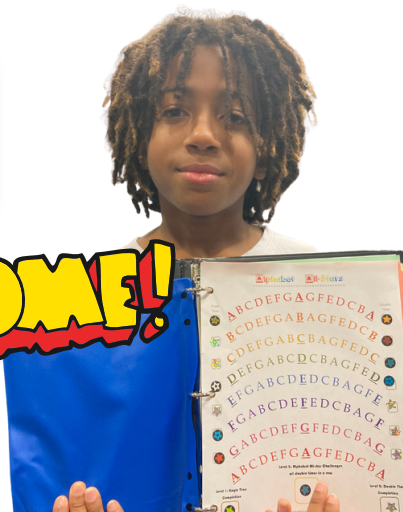
Beginner Band Notes

Beginner Band students and families are invited to attend the Sounds of the Stadium on Monday, October 2nd! It is a wonderful evening of band music that your child will get to be apart of next year! All students (except for percussion) in beginner band should have **Tradition of Excellence Book 1** for their instrument.
