Tickets are not required to watch the performance, as the performances are free, but your support in purchasing dinner is greatly appreciated.

## **Performance and Dinner Schedule**

**TOMORROW**, **November 13** is the Navo Music Night and In-N-Out Dinner. All Band, Choir, and Orchestra students in all grades are involved in this performance and we will meet right after school on Monday as soon as students are dismissed from class. We will get everyone staged and run a quick dress rehearsal in the cafeteria before our program begins at 5 pm. Students should have/wear their band, choir, or orchestra shirt and jeans on Monday.

Our program is in the cafeteria. You'll need to enter on the east side of the building by the cafeteria/portables. Please plan on coming inside to watch your child perform first and then as soon as their portion of the performance is done, you all will be dismissed to line up at the In-N-Out truck if you bought a ticket. If you didn't buy tickets, you and your child are free to leave after your child's performance.

- 5:00 pm Choirs Performing (then dismissed to eat)
- 5:20 pm Orchestras Performing (then dismissed to eat)
- 5:40 pm Beginner Band Performing (then dismissed to eat)
- 6:00 pm Advanced Band/Drumline Performing (then dismissed to eat)
- 6:20 pm Jazz Band Performing (then dismissed to eat)
- 6:30 pm OPEN CAFETERIA for family eating time (you can also eat in the cafeteria before 6:30, just be mindful of volume levels during other performance groups)

Again, all students and parents will be dismissed to line up to get food from the In-N-Out truck **AFTER** their portion of the concert ends. If your child is involved in more than one group above, we ask that you wait to line up to eat until after their final performance group. You can eat your food in the cafeteria or take it to-go. We'll also have a few tables set up outside of the cafeteria by the truck.
